

Pro Moves for Mentors

- 1 Set mutual relationship expectations.
- Share your successes and failures and what contributed to each.
- Give mentees tasks to complete and ask them to report back.
- **4** Commit meaningful time and energy.
- 5 Don't do all the talking.
 Prepare conversation-starter questions.
- **6** Verbalize what you learn from your mentee.
- Provide challenging feedback, delivered with empathy.
- 8 Ask the mentee to set up the meetings and bring their current challenges.
